

UNDO Multi-step Edits


The UNDO feature in the Geospatial Data Editor restores raster cells to their original cell values.



Begin with an agricultural raster image on which to draw land use categories.

Draw land use categories with the raster editing tools. This illustration shows five category interpretations.








Building footprints in A CAD object


Edit styles for individual buildings

Undo several style assignments


The UNDO feature restores complete TIN topology.



With the Add Edge tool, you can add a complex linear feature.



The editor automatically recomputes the TIN topology, often adding many nodes and reconfiguring edges.



When you click the Undo button, The TIN object is restored to its exact state before the line was added.
